“WE CARE” Program Overview

The Pick ‘N Save Advantage® WE CARE Program is a donation program which allows non-profit organizations the opportunity to raise additional funds by encouraging their members to shop at Pick ‘N Save food stores and use their Advantage Saver’s Club card every time they shop. A percentage of the total WE CARE dollars spent at Pick ‘N Save will be donated back to each participating non-profit organization.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THIS PROGRAM!

There are several key elements to the program that participants should be aware of:

- In order to participate in this program, you must go to the service counter at Pick ‘N Save and complete a “change” application, selecting the charity that you prefer. You can only choose one charity and only have to complete this form one time, unless you lose your card.
- In order to choose Housing Resources, Inc. as your charity, you must add our organization number of **337625** on your “change” application.
- Housing Resources will earn donations for our organization if you identify our six-digit identification number (**337625**) on your Advantage® Saver’s Club application form at your favorite Pick ‘N Save store, and by using your card every time you shop. The more you shop with your card at Pick ‘N Save, the more money that will be earned by Housing Resources, Inc.
- Any Advantage Saver’s Club cardholder can designate one authorized non-profit organization to which their household’s purchase dollars will be credited.
- Purchase dollars designated to our organization by you will be automatically accumulated, earning our organization’s share of the total dollars that Pick ‘N Save has made available.

The funds allocated by this program do not come directly from you, but come from points earned by the money you spend at Pick ‘N Save. It is a way for HRI supporters to help our agency to continue to provide the valuable services that lead many families through the purchase and home maintenance process.
